Peacebuilding Fund (PBF)

On 8th of August, **Fafa cantonment site**received an official delegation led by
Mali Minister of Defense and the Deputy Special
Representative of the Secretary-general (DSRSG),
Humanitarian Coordinator and UN Resident
Coordinator. This mission was meant to inform
local authorities, military heads, religious leaders,

civil society and armed movements of Gao region on the progress made on the construction. It was also an occasion to present to community leaders the different Community-Violence Reduction projects implemented for the benefit of the populations surrounding the site.

Main Figures

QIPs 2015-2016: 95 projects out of which 31 completed and 64 under implementation over a **total budget of 4 million USD** (204 projects since 2013 over a budget of 7.8 million USD)

Peacebuilding Fund (PBF): 5 projects started in 2015 over 18 months for a total budget of 10,932,168 USD

Trust Fund (TF): 13 projects completed/ nearing finalization and 38 projects under implementation out of 76 projects approved for a cost of 18,516,264.48 USD over a budget of 24,816,625 USD (contributions from Australia, Canada, Denmark, Germany, Ireland, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Switzerland, Turkey, the United Kingdom and UN DOCO)

On 17th of August, **a large supply of equipment (IT, motorcycles, solar power kits) were delivered to local authorities of Rharous and Niafunké communes.** This handover was organized by IOM and took place at the *Direction Régionale du Développement Social* in Timbuktu. This falls within the context of the PBF project regarding the sustainable and peaceful reintegration of internally displaced people (IDPs) and repatriated refugees in Gao and Timbuktu regions, jointly implemented by IOM and UNHCR.

Culture

On 2nd of September, MINUSMA facilitated the visit in Timbuktu of the delegation comprised of the Minister of Culture, the Ambassador of Turkey and General Director of the Center of Istanbul Research Center For Islamic History, Arts and Culture (IRCICA). The delegation visited several cultural sites including Imam Essayouti's manuscript library, rehabilitated through a QIP. This took place in the context of

reinforced cultural cooperation between Mali and the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) and of the implementation of "Timbuktu Renaissance" project. IRCICA, OIC member directly concerned by cultural aspects, intends to contribute to Malian Government efforts to fight against violent extremisms through culture and to the vast programme to preserve damaged cultural heritage in northern Mali.

Gao - Menaka

On 3rd of August, **MINUSMA Regional Office**in Gao held a working session with
the Regional Development Agency (RDA),
represented by its General Director and Heads of
technical and administrative services. Emphasizing
on the orientation and planning roles of the RDA
on projects and programmes implementation, the
General Director expressed great satisfaction on the
Regional Stabilization & Recovery Plan for Gao and
interest in regular consultations with MINUSMA.

Also on 10th of August, the **launch of the rehabilitation and equipment of the Maison des anciens combattants** took place
with the *Préfet* and MINUSMA Force Commander
in attendance. This QIP sponsored by the Military
Component of the Mission amounts to a total value of
42,446.48 USD. The project aims to improve working
conditions for 348 war veterans of Gao and will also
benefit to 72 widows and 108 orphans.

On 9th of August, 4 QIPs were launched in Menaka: (1) rehabilitation and equipment of the Rural Radio (sponsored by MINUSMA Public Information Office), (2) rehabilitation of the Courthouse, (3) rehabilitation of the Prison (both sponsored by Justice & Corrections section), (4) rehabilitation of a sports facilities (sponsored by MINUSMA Civil-Military Coordination). For a total value of approx. 170,000 USD, these projects aim at sustaining social cohesion and access to justice.

For a total budget of 43,191.08 USD, this initiative intends to increase job opportunities through fishing, breeding and gardening and to restrain rural exodus and youth mobilization in armed groups.

Kidal

On 15th of August, **two QIPs were launched**• **for the "construction of adjunct premises**and **fence for the Maison des associations in Kidal"**, sponsored by MINUSMA Civil Affairs Division
for a total budget of nearly 70,000 USD. This launch
was marked by a training in administration and
conflict management addressed to the Management
Committee. The initiative is implemented by
ASSAGHSSAL NGO and aims at supporting
associations' and civil society organizations' activities,
providing them with equipped amenities, and
facilitating population's access to these organizations.

Thanks to solar power kits, **more than 2.000 households of Kidal region now have access to electricity**. According to beneficiaries, impact of those kits is tremendous, as they improve security as well as living conditions. To achieve this, several projects benefited from complementary funds of the QIP programme and the Trust Fund (through the contribution of Canada).

2 In a region where the supply of gardening products and fresh crops faces many challenges, MINUSMA targeted 20 associations and groups to improve local gardening production. On 26th of August, in Angamali neighbourhood of Kidal, MINUSMA Regional Office launched activities related to this gardening development project in Kidal, Essouk and Anefis communes. In attendance were the beneficiaries as well as representatives of civil society organizations, NGOs and CMA, who thanked the Mission for this major intervention. The initiative will directly benefit to 600

growers for a cost of 258,110 USD funded through the contribution of Denmark to the Trust Fund in Support of Peace and Security in Mali. Over a 6-months period, the implementation is entrusted to NGO consortium made of ASSADDEC, GARDL, AFORD and CAMR.

Timbuktu - Taoudeni

From 9th to 11th of August, MINUSMA Regional Office in Timbuktu organized a capacitybuilding workshop on the fight against conflictrelated sexual and gender-based violence (SGBV), in the benefit of penal chain stakeholders and civil society organization of the region. This activity is part of the Annual Plan for improvement of access to justice and security for SGBV-affected women in the peace consolidation process in Mali. It was funded through the Peacebuilding Fund project related to the Gender Promotion Initiative and jointly implemented by UNWOMEN, UNFPA and MINUSMA. At the end of the workshop, six coordination and monitoring units were put in place, dedicated to the fight against SGBV within the penal chain (Police, Justice and Prison Administration) and civil society.

On 16th of August, the QIP project for the provision of a local products transformation unit for women associations in Timbuktu Cercle was officially launched at the *Direction Régionale de la Promotion de l'Enfant, de la Femme et de la Famille*. For a value of 42,000 USD, this QIP is sponsored by MINUSMA Civil Affairs Division and aims at improving revenues of those associations, reducing vulnerability of the women involved and promoting social cohesion.

On 25th of August, activities started for the QIP related to "economic reintegration of conflict-affected women in Timbuktu", a project sponsored by MINUSMA Human Rights Division for a value of 33,739.57 USD. The project aims at providing gardening training and equipment to 45 women in view of their empowerment and socio-economic integration. It will guarantee regular fruits and vegetables supplies in Timbuktu markets, but also initiate income-generating activities, fight against gender stigmatization and promote conflict prevention.

These projects will benefit mainly northern regions and will support requests from the Malian Government, international and national NGOs, international agencies and civil society. All projects are executed through local partners and businesses.

Financed by MINUSMA, Quick Impact Projects (QIPs) are community micro projects. These projects have a maximum cost of 50,000 USD and a maximum 6-months duration, in the areas of services and small public infrastructures rehabilitation, training and awareness-raising activities, employment and revenue creation. They must have both a quick and long lasting

effect meeting priority needs of the population and aim at building confidence towards the peace process, the Mission and its mandate.

From 2013 to 2015, 109 projects were implemented (1st and 2nd years). Between 1st of July 2015 until 30th of June 2016 (3rd year), a 4 million USD budget will be dedicated to approximately 114 QIPs.

The UN Trust Fund in support of Peace and Security in Mali was created at the request of the Security Council (SC resolution 2085 (2012)). Member States can contribute earmarked and/or non-earmarked funds to the Fund, which aims to provide vital support to the Malian Defence and Security Forces (MDSF), assist the Malian Government in its efforts to ensure lasting peace and the return of State Authority and constitutional order, and support critical development and humanitarian interventions contributing to the immediate and long-term efforts by the international community to resolve the crisis in Mali.

It is supported by voluntary contributions from the following donors: Australia, Canada, Denmark, Germany, Ireland, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Switzerland, Turkey, the United Kingdom and UN DOCO. Timbuktu The Fund's budget currently amounts to approximately 24.8 million USD, of which some 75 per cent has been attributed to projects.


Peacebuilding Fund in Mali -**Overview**

To deal with the political, institutional and security crisis that deeply destabilized Mali since 2012, the Malian Government and the United Nations System in Mali resorted to the Peacebuilding Fund (PBF) in order to support peacebuilding and reconciliation. The Government of Mali submitted an eligibility request to the Peacebuilding Support Office (PBSO) on 24th of February 2014 which was approved by Secretary-General of the United Nations on 2nd of April 2014.

In this context, the intervention of the PBF programme in Mali represents in its first phase 10.9 million USD, of which 10.6 have been attributed to 5 projects undertaken by UN agencies and MINUSMA. A Steering Committee oversees the whole programme and gathers the Malian Government, the civil society, international donors and the United Nations. The remaining 0.3 million USD goes to the Steering Committee Support Office.
