# **Donor Coordination and Partnerships**

**1** On 15<sup>th</sup> of July, **France co-chaired with MINUSMA the Commission Réhabilitation des Zones Post-Conflit (CRZPC) enlarged to iNGOs**, with 4 points of discussion. (1) MSAHRN General Secretary presented Malian Government's dissemination efforts of the peace process to the population and requested financial and technical support to international partners in view of future awareness-raising activities and the organization of the *Conférence d'Entente Nationale* stipulated by the Peace Agreement. (2) The Agence de Développement du Nord du Mali (ADNM) informed on the progress made on Synergie Nord, an online platform centralizing all development and recovery partners' interventions in the northern and central regions with the possibility for all actors to update and export data for dissemination. (3) In follow-up on the workshop of the conflict-sensitive project management held in June, several dissemination sessions on main findings intended to programme operators at regional level, through a roster of trainers. (4) 2016-2017 schools reopening was also discussed with the urgent need to trigger the preparation process in an inclusive approach engaging the Government of Mali and signatory Movements.

Trust Fund (TF): 13 projects completed/nearing finalization and 33 projects under implementation out of 72 projects approved for a cost of 18,049,946 USD over a budget of 24,438,625 USD (contributions from Australia, Canada, Denmark, Germany, Ireland, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Switzerland, Turkey, the United Kingdom and UN DOCO)

## **Peacebuilding Fund (PBF)**

**1**. From 26<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> of July, a capacitybuilding workshop in law enforcement against conflict-related gender-based violence took place, addressed to Penal Chain entities, Malian Security Forces officials and CSOs representatives of Gao region. This was organized by UNWOMEN, MINUSMA Women Protection Unit, Human Rights Division, Justice & Corrections Section and UNPOL jointly with the aforementioned actors and funded through the PBF project aiming at improving access to justice and security for women victims of sexual and gender-based violence. The training team consisted of UNWOMEN and MINUSMA staff, as well as local experts. The *Procureur de la République*, Gao Governor Adviser and Head of MINUSMA Regional Office in Gao were present at the opening ceremony.

**1** On 14<sup>th</sup> of July, **S&R Timbuktu organized an orientation session on QIPs proposal formulation for 20 youths of Salam Rural Commune**. ## **Mopti**

On 2<sup>nd</sup> of July, S&R Mopti participated in the handover ceremony of the new Centre de Santé Communautaire (CSCOM) of Tongorongo in the presence of a representative of the Direction Régionale de la Santé. Sponsored by MINUSMA DDR for a value of 42,568.59 USD, this QIP consisted of the construction of the CSCOM and provision of

All three UNPOL-sponsored projects amount to a total budget of approx. 115,000 USD and focus on strengthening operational capacities of Malian Security Forces in Mopti region by improving their working conditions.

The event was followed by the forum for reconciliation and peace organized by youths on the occasion and in the presence of the Mayor, Sous-préfet, notabilities and MINUSMA Head of **Regional Office.** 

On 20th of July, the handover ceremony for 2 QIPs sponsored by MINUSMA Justice & Corrections section (JCS) took place at Mopti Prison: (1) gardening production and training for detainees (41,770.64 USD budget); (2) security reinforcement of the prison (41,441.85 USD). The ceremony was chaired by Mopti Governor in the presence of the Deputy National Director and Regional Director of Penitentiary Services, military authorities and Head of JCS section. While the first project is intended to promote professional training of detainees, the second one aims at improving detention conditions as well as the working environment for the prison staff. Financed by MINUSMA, Quick Impact Projects (QIPs) are community micro projects. These projects have a maximum cost of 50,000 USD and a maximum 6-months duration, in the areas of services and small public infrastructures rehabilitation, training and awareness-raising activities, employment and revenue creation. They must have both a quick and long lasting effect meeting priority needs of the population and aim at building confidence towards the peace process, the Mission and its mandate.

From 2013 to 2015, 109 projects were implemented (1st and 2nd years). Between 1st of July 2015 until 30th of June 2016 (3<sup>rd</sup> year), a 4 million USD budget will be dedicated to approximately 114 QIPs.

These projects will benefit mainly northern regions and will support requests from the Malian Government, international and national NGOs, international agencies and civil society. All projects are executed through local partners and businesses.

# Peacebuilding Fund in Mali -Overview

To deal with the political, institutional and security crisis that deeply destabilized Mali since 2012, the Malian Government and the United Nations System in Mali resorted to the Peacebuilding Fund (PBF) in order to support peacebuilding and reconciliation. The Government of Mali submitted an eligibility request to the Peacebuilding Support Office (PBSO) on  $24^{th}$  of February 2014 which was approved by Secretary-General of the United Nations on  $2^{nd}$  of April 2014.

In this context, the intervention of the PBF programme in Mali represents in its first phase 10.9 million USD, of which 10.6 have been attributed to 5 projects undertaken by UN agencies and MINUSMA. A Steering Committee oversees the whole programme and gathers the Malian Government, the civil society, international donors and the United Nations. The remaining 0.3 million USD goes to the Steering Committee Support Office.

### Education project for peacebuilding in the north of Mali UNICEF

The agency and its partners implement a speed school strategy for not attending and out-of-school children. Fora for inclusive community dialogue are also set up for social cohesion at school, within the family and community.



## Support to capacity-building in conflict resilience for women and youth in Gao and Timbuktu regions UNDP, UNIDO

This joint project accompanies national reconciliation and dialog promotion creating economic opportunities in favor of vulnerable women and at-risk youths.



#### Confidence-building through support to the Cantonment process UNOPS

Operations strengthen mutual trust between peace agreement signatories and favor security climate appeasement. Rooting of the disarmament process in the country goes through fighters' cantonment, among other steps. UNOPS is in charge of the construction and management of camps intended for this purpose.

This project consists in providing IDPs and repatriated refugees access to basic social services and reinforcing peaceful cohabitation between local communities in a climate of increased trust in the peace process.

Both agencies and the Mission assist SGBV victims facilitating access to justice and holistic care. The project also supports capacity-building of care services and judicial system in terms of SGBV.
