### **Donor Coordination and Partnerships**

**1** On 8<sup>th</sup> of September, the **Commission Réhabilitation des Zones Post-Conflit** (**CRZPC**) was the opportunity for donors and international NGOs to discuss the social and security situation in the North, their ongoing support to Interim Authorities and upcoming school reopening (with the Education Cluster in charge of lobbying efforts to mobilize all stakeholders around this important issue).

#### Culture

**1** On 19<sup>th</sup> of September, **the Mission facilitated a visit to Timbuktu in the frame of its support to the heritage rehabilitation programme coordinated by the Ministry of Culture and UNESCO**. The delegation participated to the ceremony organized by the inhabitants to reinstall the sacred gate of the mosque Sidi Yahia after restoration. The gate, which bears testimony to cultural traditions dating back to the 15<sup>th</sup> century

CE, had been pulled out and damaged on 2<sup>nd</sup> of July 2012 by armed extremists. The delegation included the Secretary-General of the Ministry of Culture, the DSRSG/RC/HC and the Representative of UNESCO in Mali as well as the Ambassador of the European Union. The reinstallation of the sacred gate marks a new and symbolic step in Mali's cultural heritage reconstruction and peace building work.

Trust Fund (TF): 13 projects completed/ nearing finalization and 38 projects under implementation out of 76 projects approved for a cost of 18,516,264.48 USD over a budget of 24,816,625 USD (contributions from Australia, Canada, Denmark, Germany, Ireland, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Switzerland, Turkey, the United Kingdom and UN DOCO)

2. S&R Culture unit supported logistically the holding of the 8<sup>th</sup> edition of the workshop "Fotocreation" organized by the African House of Photography of the Ministry of Culture. This annual event took place for the first time ever in the city of Timbuktu from 29<sup>th</sup> of September to 8<sup>th</sup> of October. The workshop aimed to strengthen the skills and encourage exchanges and creativity between 15 Malian photographers from all regions and the district of Bamako. The images produced will also serve to create a collection of photography books on the cities of Mali. The support provided by MINUSMA is part of facilitating the relaunching of cultural events in the northern regions as stipulated in the Agreement for peace and reconciliation in Mali.

#### Mopti

**1** On 8<sup>th</sup> of September, **the Deputy Special Representative of the Secretary-General (DSRSG) and the Ambassador of Canada officially inaugurated the newly secured Sévaré FAMa camp**, a project funded through the Trust Fund in Support for Peace and Security. It was also an opportunity to meet the Deputy Governor, President of Regional Council, local NGOs and the UN Country Team in Mopti.

2. On 13<sup>th</sup> of September, **the borehole equipped** with a drinking water supply system in Kanio, Mopti region, has been officially handed over to local authorities. The QIP project is sponsored by MINUSMA Civil Affairs Division for 39,153.15 USD and will directly benefit to 1,600 local residents by guaranteeing a regular supply of drinking water and reducing risks due to water-related diseases.

#### **Kidal**

On 20th of September, the rehabilitation of 2 schools in Kidal and Anefis was launched. Children in Kidal region have not had access to education since the crisis in 2012 due to the absence of the educational administration, the absence of teachers, the degradation of educational infrastructure and the looting of schools. The project foresees the rehabilitation and equipment of 3 schools in total, the provision of campaigns around the return of children to school, the capacity building of the school management committees, the provision of latrines and water fountains and hygiene sensitization campaigns. Funded for 206,000 USD through the Danish contribution to the Trust Fund and sponsored by MINUSMA Civil Affairs Division, the initiative will be implemented by a consortium of 3 local NGOs (ARDL, CAMR, ASSAHSAL) and aims to benefit 1,200 students.

On 30th of September, the creation of a **2**• fodder purchase centre officially started in Kidal. This project, funded for 273,524 USD through the Danish contribution to the Trust Fund, will be implemented by 5 local NGOs and benefit to the 55,000 breeders of the region. Kidal region knows important periods of drought during which no grazing lands are available for livestock. In the absence of grazing lands, fodder needs to be purchased to sustain herds. However, fodder prices considerably increase when demand is the highest. The construction of a central purchase centre where fodder could be stored and then sold at fixed prices will help overcome this challenge. The intervention is expected to provide important relief for the population and as such represents a significant peace dividend for the region. The project will include the construction of the centre, the provision of 350 tons of fodder, the establishment of a management committee and sensitization sessions with the population.

#### Peacebuilding Fund (PBF)

**1** The first phase of the Peacebuilding Fund in Mali (see the overview pages 8-9) ended in June 2016. 5 major projects gathered 8 UN agencies and MINUSMA on issues related to education, socioeconomic recovery, reintegration of IDPs, justice and cantonment. **Discover some of the achievements made possible thanks to the PBF here:** https://youtu.be/76SuBvvksPA ►

Financed by MINUSMA, Quick Impact Projects (QIPs) are community micro projects. These projects have a maximum cost of 50,000 USD and a maximum 6-months duration, in the areas of services and small public infrastructures rehabilitation, training and awareness-raising activities, employment and revenue creation. They must have both a quick and long lasting

effect meeting priority needs of the population and aim at building confidence towards the peace process, the Mission and its mandate.

From 2013 to 2015, 109 projects were implemented (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> years). Between 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2015 until 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2016 (3<sup>rd</sup> year), a 4 million USD budget will be dedicated to approximately 114 QIPs.

These projects will benefit mainly northern regions and will support requests from the Malian Government, international and national NGOs, international agencies and civil society. All projects are executed through local partners and businesses.

To deal with the political, institutional and security crisis that deeply destabilized Mali since 2012, the Malian Government and the United Nations System in Mali resorted to the Peacebuilding Fund (PBF) in order to support peacebuilding and reconciliation. The Government of Mali submitted an eligibility request to the Peacebuilding Support Office (PBSO) on 24<sup>th</sup> of February 2014 which was approved by Secretary-General of the United Nations on 2<sup>nd</sup> of April 2014.

In this context, the intervention of the PBF programme in Mali represents in its first phase 10.9 million USD, of which 10.6 have been attributed to 5 projects undertaken by UN agencies and MINUSMA. A Steering Committee oversees the whole programme and gathers the Malian Government, the civil society, international donors and the United Nations. The remaining 0.3 million USD goes to the Steering Committee Support Office.







#### Education project for peacebuilding in the north of Mali UNICEF

The agency and its partners implement a speed school strategy for not attending and out-of-school children. Fora for inclusive community dialogue are also set up for social cohesion at school, within the family and community.



#### Support to capacity-building in conflict resilience for women and youth in Gao and Timbuktu regions UNDP, UNIDO

This joint project accompanies national reconciliation and dialog promotion creating economic opportunities in favor of vulnerable women and at-risk youths.



#### Confidence-building through support to the Cantonment process UNOPS

Operations strengthen mutual trust between peace agreement signatories and favor security climate appeasement. Rooting of the disarmament process in the country goes through fighters' cantonment, among other steps. UNOPS is in charge of the construction and management of camps intended for this purpose.



Solutions for a sustainable and peaceful reintegration of internally displaced people (IDPs) and repatriated refugees in Gao and Timbuktu regions *IOM, UNHCR* 

This project consists in providing IDPs and repatriated refugees access to basic social services and reinforcing peaceful cohabitation between local communities in a climate of increased trust in the peace process.



#### Programme for a better access to justice and security for women victims of SGBV in the peacebuilding process in Mali UN Women, UNFPA, MINUSMA

Both agencies and the Mission assist SGBV victims facilitating access to justice and holistic care. The project also supports capacity-building of care services and judicial system in terms of SGBV.
