# Fast Facts - Uniformed Personnel

In its **Resolution 2364** (30 June 2017), the Security Council authorized 13,289 military personnel and 1,920 police personnel for MINUSMA until 30 June 2018.

**MINUSMA**

## MANDATE

- To support the full implementation of [the Agreement on Peace and reconciliation in Mali](#), in particular in its political dimensions and aspects linked to security, notably to support the Government efforts for the effective restoration and extension of State authority and rule of law throughout the territory ;
- To [support logistically and financially](#) the cantonment, disarmament, demobilization and reintegration of armed groups, including through the integration of elements of the signatory armed groups in the Malian Defense and Security Force (MDSF) ;
- To [ensure the protection of civilians](#) under immediate threat of physical violence without prejudice to the primary responsibility of the Malian authorities ;
- To [support](#) the conduct of transparent, free, and inclusive elections, including through the provision of appropriate technical assistance and security arrangements, consistent with the provisions of the Agreement ;
- To [support national and international efforts](#) towards rebuilding the Malian security sector, especially the Police and Gendarmerie, through technical assistance, capacity-building, co-location and mentoring programs ;
- In [support of the Malian authorities](#), to stabilize the key population centres, notably in the North and Centre of Mali, and, in this regard, to enhance early warning through active and effective patrolling and to anticipate, deter and counter threats ;

## SECURITY & PROTECTION

1 July 2013 - 31 March 2018 :

**143,962** military patrols and **56,611** police patrols to deter threats and protect civilians  
**341 tons** of obsolete and non-usable weapons and ammunitions confiscated and destroyed by FAMa with support from MINUSMA  
**982** members of the Malian security forces trained in counter IED measures including **68** women.  
**29,079** members of the Malian security forces trained by UN Police including **2,956** women (some police officers followed several trainings)
